“How do we live as Christians in an Anti-Christian Culture?”

Scriptures: Daniel 3:1-6, 9-13, 16-18, 28-30

Commentary: Believe it or not there was a time when people of other nations believed that to be born in the United States meant you were Christian, after all it was the reason we fought so hard to become an independent nation to worship God in freedom. We may not want to believe it or accept it but the fact of the matter is this trend is more and more further from the truth. True Christianity is being challenged more in our culture now than ever before. I am inclined to believe that if something doesn't change we may be facing similar bondages as our ancestors did in Biblical times.

Pharaoh's army drowned in the Red Sea- Exodus 14: 26-30
Peter and the Apostles deliverance from jail- Acts 5:17-21
Paul's many deliverances

Conclusion: God does not expect us to lay down and ignore injustices of any kind whether they be social or moral, but what He expects us to do is to bring Him into the situation that He may take control and win the victory such that He gets the glory. It was Daniel's humility, trust and submission that got him an audience with king Nebuchadnezzar and we all know how that turned out.
