“Expect God to Move”

Scripture: Acts 4:23-37

Commentary:

The worth of a believer is not measured in the number of works that he or she performs, but in how closely aligned they are with the movement and substance of the Holy Spirit. If a believer knows that when he or she prays, speaks, praises, worships, and gives the Holy Spirit time to move, then there is a “shift” in countenance, vision, attitude and preparedness because God is

confirming that He is near.

When God is near change is inevitable!

When God is near His Kingdom is realized!

When God is near His revelation is tangible!

When God is near the His fruit is edible!

Like the disciples and other followers, it was not until the Holy Spirit draws nearer that we can “expect God to move.” And note that He will move as He has done throughout the centuries. For our edification, what did the disciples and other followers of Jesus Christ do before, during, and after Pentecost to sustain the atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to continue presenting Himself in their light?

Teaching – Read Acts 4:23-37

Stage (1): verses (11-22)

The Word was revealed before skeptics.

An attitude of fearlessness/boldness was revealed.

Signs followed the Word being revealed.

They were consistent in delivering the message of truth.

The Word of God was given followed by intense praise.

Stage (2)

The disciples prayed out loud.

They ministered to the Lord Our God with intentionality.

They spoke revelation (past and present).

They ask the Lord our God to consider their circumstances (with the right standing and attitude).

Stage (3)

They “expected God to move” and He did upon the external ground and then, He moved upon them.

They were immersed in the presence of His Holy Spirit.

Stage (4)

Upon their immersion they reached oneness in “heart and mind.”

They sold their possessions and shared with others.

They were revealed as equal in God’s sight.

They testified to the single most important fact since the Immaculate, Conception, and Holy Birth; that was the Resurrection!

They received an increase of God’s Grace.

Possessions were pooled to help those less fortunate.

Deep expressions of submission and order were expressed.

The Leaders led the way (among the people) by example.

Questions:

Why does it take so much to be positioned to see God move?

Were the disciples any different than you are today?

Why is it necessary to reveal God’s greatest to nonbelievers?

Can God enlarge your territory? How?

Will the Word of God unlock doors that no man can open and close and that we should not open ever again?
