“Is the Bride Ready”

Commentary:

When an individual decides to receive Salvation he or she becomes a part of the Body of Christ. From that moment the process of unification begins, and it is essential because God’s creation must return to HIM.

After making this decision, a new believer must decide to let Jesus the Christ be Lord of his or her life. Then and only then can the “courtship” begin!

Gladly, the Lord Jesus sends His Spirit to witness, to change and to equip us in order to assure, prepare and enforce His Plan for a wedding that fulfills the Prophecy shared by the Apostle John in the Book of Revelation.

We must yield to the Holy Spirit’s instructions if we are to reflect Him in each aspect of our lives. Note that along our life’s path *Purpose and Destiny* will be revealed. Once, we (as believers) are prepared, the marriage ceremony can take place.

Now that you are a part of the Bride, the question that must be addressed is “are you ready to enter the courtship and eventually marriage with Jesus the Christ?”

Questions:

What should we do to prepare for the Bride Groom? (Who is Our Lord and Savior Jesus the Christ)

1. Love unconditionally
2. Honor & Reverence the One who knows you
3. Trust and lean not...
4. Walk in Faith
5. Give
6. Praise and Worship (both are essential)
7. Gather the widows, widowers, the youth, the under nourished and unchurched.
8. Protect the Sanctuary and the Word
9. Witness to the lost
10. Strive towards holiness (give yourself up!)

Conclusions – Derived from Revelation 21:9-27

1. The NT Church is a part of the Bride.
 - a. We are the Church.
2. The Apostle John witness the gathering of the New Jerusalem and the nations that are brought to it.
3. The Nations will walk by the Light that needs no Sun or Moon for the Glory of the Lord gives it Light.
4. Kings will bring splendor, glory and honor to the marriage.
5. Only those whose names are written in the “Lambs Book of Life” will enter.
 - a. Those who are pre-destined and saved.
6. The Bride will be ready when believers decide to honor God, receive His Advocate (His Spirit of Truth, His Counselor) in advance of His Coming.
7. The Church is the Bride. Are you truly a part of the Church?
