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THE ANOINTING

GOD'S SUPERNATURAL POWER TO GET THINGS
DONE THROUGH HIS PEOPLE

“God Will Anoint You (through His Spirit)”

Scriptures: Acts 1:8, 2:17-21

Commentary:

The Holy Spirit cannot arrive in any setting without “signs and wonders.” Clearly, the Lord Our God wants His Sons and Daughters to hear and understand that when the Holy Spirit comes you will know it! But, let me caution you to keep in mind that feeling the presence of God is not the goal of spiritual growth. Trying to feel the presence of God will put you in a self-effort mode and increase your fears that you might not be able to “achieve.” The resulting fears will shut you down inside so that it will become even more difficult for you to be open to God so you can receive His presence by faith in His grace. If you don’t feel God’s presence you can’t let yourself worry about it. Get your heart to believe that by reassuring yourself that feeling His presence isn’t the goal. The goal is to stay close to the Lord, enjoy times of refreshing from His presence—by faith. Thrill your heart with the radiance you believe God is showering upon you. Lovingly worship Him. Thank Him that you are not less of a Christian if you have not felt His presence yet. You just have to keep removing the obstacles that keep you away from God. Listen to your thanks and praise for the truth so that you nurture freedom to draw near and enjoy God. After that, when you do begin to feel God’s presence thank God often that you don’t have to worship yourself because of His presence with you. If you make that mistake you will find you are falling in love with yourself and that your pursuit toward God is decreasing. If you do find you are making these kinds of mistakes don’t waste any time redirecting your heart toward God by thanks and praise for the truth.

Teaching:

1. You have the anointing of God flowing through you when God’s heart touches another person’s heart through your heart. The anointing of God is the Holy Spirit. He flows as a river of love, from the throne of grace, through the hearts of believers, bringing life to all that receive His touch.

2. God anoints people that love Him more than they love their own lives, and that love others as themselves. As we open our hearts to love others God’s anointing flows through us. When we close our hearts to others and grieve the Holy Spirit the flow stops. (1 John 3:17), (Proverbs 4:23)

3. The anointing of the Holy Spirit is given through people to demonstrate God’s love and power. Christ means the “Anointed One”. Because Christ is in us the same anointing that He had on earth we also have. (Luke 4:18-19)

The Anointing:

1. The anointing is given to preach the Gospel to the poor. (Luke 4:18)
2. The anointing is given to heal and restore people (Acts 10:36-38).
3. The anointing is given to proclaim freedom to the captives (2 Timothy 2:24-26).

4. The anointing is given to open blind eyes. (2 Corinthians 4:3-4) (Revelation 3:18).
5. The anointing is given to set people free. Isaiah 10:27), (John 8:36).
6. The anointing flows in God’s timing and proclaims God’s timing. (Ephesians 2:10)
7. God’s anointing flows to those who are hungry for a touch from His Holy Spirit. (Luke 6:19-20), (Matthew 5:3)
8. The anointing can be stifled if the people refuse to receive it from the person that God is sending it through. (Matthew 13:57-58), (Matthew 10:13-14).
9. The anointing of the Holy Spirit is a gift from God. (John 4:10), (John 4:13-14)
10. The anointing gives wisdom. (1 John 2:20), (1 John 2:27).
11. The anointing is the river of life that flows from the throne through your heart and penetrates other people’s hearts. (Psalms 36:7-9), (Psalms 46:4)
12. As we continue in the river of God’s anointing it intensifies until we are carried by it. (Ezekiel 47:1-10).
13. The anointing is given to intercede for people. (Isaiah 59:16-21).
14. The free flowing anointing of God’s love brings joy to God and that joy is felt by the person He flows through. (Psalms 45:3-7) (Isaiah 58:6-12).
15. Everyone in the body of Christ is anointed with the Holy Spirit, and we all need to give from God’s anointing to each other, and we all need to be able to receive the anointing that comes through other Christians. (1 Corinthians 12:4-12) (Ephesians 4:11-16)
16. The anointing is sacred, the anointing is the Holy Spirit, and all believers in Christ have the anointing of the Holy Spirit. We must be careful what we say about our brothers and sisters in Christ. (Matthew 12:31), (1 Chronicles 16:22-24).
