

Revelatory Comments:

In these most critical times, the Remnant of the Lord Jesus should "hasten" to see the Glory of God! Nothing should restrict or restrain us. In the pursuit of God's Glory, we should reflect the attitude and tone of the Apostle Paul when he states in the Book of Romans verses 31-39. Knowing that Paul's pursuit led him beyond Damascus to God's Glory, we should strive to find our place on the road to witness God's Glory. "What is the meaning of "To God Be the glory?" God is the Supreme Being and Creator of all. To glorify HIM means that we are to acknowledge the greatness and splendor of His Majesty through honor, worship, praise, study, and giving of which He alone is worthy because He is God of all.

Teaching:

When experiencing God's presence note that...

The Holy Spirit reveals God's Glory and HE serves as the Greatest Gift given to mankind. When HE comes: NO disease or sickness can remain, NO temptation can remain, NO degree of darkness can remain, NO doubt can remain, NO fear can remain, NO confusion can remain, NO hatred can remain.

Fact: YOU will know that the Kingdom of God has come when the HOLY SPIRIT enters and remains! When the Holy Spirit comes HE delivers GOD'S ANOINTING! (Phase III)

Revelatory Comments:

"What is the meaning of "To God Be the glory?" God is the Supreme Being and Creator of all. To glorify HIM means that we are to acknowledge the greatness and splendor of His Majesty through honor, worship, praise, study, and giving of which He alone is worthy because He is God of all.

In Acts 17:28 it states that "For in HIM we live and move and have our being. As some of your own poets have said, 'We are HIS offspring." Therefore to be HIS off-spring we are to carry HIS ANOINTING and readily give HIM the GLORY that HE so richly deserves!

- 1. The free flowing anointing of God's love brings joy to God and that joy is felt by the person He flows through. Love is the joy we get from God when we put His benefit and the benefit of another person before our own. (Psalms 45:3-7) (Isaiah 58:6-12)
- 2. Everyone in the body of Christ is anointed with the Holy Spirit, and we all need to give from God's anointing to each other, and we all need to be able to receive the anointing that comes through other Christians.
- (1 Corinthians 12:4-12), (Ephesians 4:11-16)
- 3. The anointing is sacred, the anointing is the Holy Spirit, and all believers in Christ have the anointing of the Holy Spirit. We must be careful what we say about our brothers and sisters in Christ. (Matthew 12:31) (1 Chronicles 16:22-24)

To GOD BE the Glory is:

But to access HIS presence you must...

- 1. Just Be More Aware of God's presence? (James 4:8)
- **2. Cry Out to HIM!** (Psalm 34:17)
- **3.** "Come to Me" Enter the Throne Room (John 7:37, 2 Cor. 3:18, Heb. 12:2). The perfection of your faith is dependent on your applying this principle. Don't hold back. You only need to apply the scriptures and not try to imagine something that isn't accurate.
- **4. Enter the Throne Room by Faith**—*Not* by Soul Travel! Don't be mistaken. Our access to God does not mean "soul travel" into heaven as a way to stand before Him there. King David said, "Let us go to the sanctuary of the Lord; let us worship at the footstool of his throne. (Micah 4:2, Ezekiel 37:27). And, Paul wrote, "Do you not know that you are a temple of God" (1 Cor. 3:16a).
- 5. The Holy Spirit Brings You into the Throne Room

That you can enter the throne room is something that God does. You don't have to achieve it yourself. Thank the Lord often for this truth: "...in Christ Jesus our Lord...we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him." (Ephesians 3:12, 13). Listen to what you are saying. Thank the Lord until your faith is in *Him*.

6. Into the Throne Room - Through the veil? It was because Jesus lived a sinless life that His death bought us the forgiveness of God (Lev. 22:21; 1 Peter 1:18, 19; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 9:22).
