“Oh Taste and See that the Lord is Good”

Scripture: Psalm 34: 1-14

Commentary:

The Psalmist reveals the substance of David’s relationship with the Lord. A relationship that we (all) need to capture. For many, the idea of drawing so close to the Lord may seem frightening or just plain hard to measure. The Lord has never intended to frighten but to love us. The world and its interpretation of God has sought to carry us on a divergent path such that we would not embrace the opportunity to draw closer and therefore learn the TRUTH. The year 2019 will provide every believer with the opportunity to draw close enough to the Lord to discover not only HIS attributes but HIS PLAN for our lives. GOD is near! I believe that HE is closer to us today than ever!

Read Psalm 34: 1-14

The Interpretation:

*I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.
2 I will glory in the LORD; let the afflicted hear and rejoice. 3 Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt his name together. 4 I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears. 5 Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame. 6 This poor man called, and the LORD heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles. 7 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them. 8 Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him. 9 Fear the LORD, you his holy people, for those who fear him lack nothing. 10 The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing. 11 Come, my children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD. 12 Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days, 13 keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies. 14 Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.*

The Fundamentals:

1. In the midst of any situation, GOD’s word is on my tongue.
2. When I lift up the Lord Jesus the natural and spiritual atmosphere changes.
3. If I am purposed in giving HIM, the glory others will come along side me.
4. If I am true to my pursuit, HE is true to respond.
5. If I stay in HIS FACE, then HIS light will shine through me.
6. GOD is no respecter of persons.
7. When we fear HIM, HE protects us.
8. When I draw close enough to HIM, HE lets me experience HIS KINGDOM.
9. If I carry a holy fear for HIM, HE will supply my needs.
10. The Lord’s children will never be abandoned.
11. If you do not know the Lord will teach you that holy fear produces eternal wisdom.
- 12 & 13. Quality and Longevity of life can be guaranteed if we are constantly cleansed.
14. Repent, be reconciled, and receive the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

Conclusion: Are you a man or woman after God’s own heart?

We are told that **David** pleased **God**, and that he was a **man after God's own heart**. We also recognize him as a model of what it means to be a man of faith. David loved the Lord with all of his heart, soul, mind, and strength, and this love finds expression in obedience. A man or woman after God's heart, however, is not a perfect man or woman. He/She is a one who sees sin for what it is and repents of it. That David did; divine chastening had a perfecting work.
