“A Church Filled with God’s Fruit”

Commentary:

Can you imagine what it will be like when the Church of Jesus Christ is filled with all of HIS FRUIT? HIS CHURCH will be running over with believers and people seeking to believe! There would be no room! Every fire and capacity code would be broken! But, with all those people there would be order because with the FRUIT comes HOLY ORDER! What does it take to ascend to that place? How can we (who are pursuing the FRUIT of HIS SPIRIT) capture and keep these eternal attributes?

Scripture: Galatians 5:22-23

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Teaching:

1. In order to experience a Church filled with the Fruit one must:
Live by HIS SPIRIT! Examine Galatians 5:13-18
2. If you do not live by HIS SPIRIT look what comes rushing in:
Examine Galatians 5:19-21
3. The only way that you can live by HIS SPIRIT you must belong to HIM.
Examine Galatians 5:24

How do you know that you belong to Christ?

- You WANT God to change you.
- You are willing to learn to trust Him with everything and you want to give up your own control.
- You are willing to submit to Him – meaning, He is in charge now, not you. He is Lord of your life. He is the Master.
- You are willing to seek His will above your own.
- You know His wisdom is much greater than yours.
- You see Him changing you over time to be more like Jesus.
- You desire Him, or you want to learn to desire Him more than anything else.
- Things of this world begin to be less and less important.
- Things of God begin to be more and more important.
- You want to hear His voice and obey Him. You learn to recognize His voice and you want to be quick to do whatever He commands.
- You want to spend time with Him.

- You want to please God rather than people.
- You want to hear solid Bible teaching/preaching.
- You are willing to receive life-giving rebukes from God and from mature, godly, wise believers.
- You want to share this Greatest Treasure with many other people.
- You are passionate about God and you want to be even more on fire for Him.
- You have His peace and joy in your heart.
- You want to love God above everything in life and love other people.
- If you see that you are putting anything above Christ in your life and heart, you are willing to get rid of it no matter how painful it might be.
- You are willing to be content with what you have because your contentment comes from Christ Jesus, not your circumstances.
- You are willing to learn to be thankful for suffering, knowing God is using that to prune, refine, and mature you.
- You want to praise and thank Him.
- You want to pray.
- You want to bless others.
- You want to be with other believers.
- You want to take care of the poor, the oppressed, those who are hurting, etc.
- You want to love those who mistreat you.
- You want to forgive and not hold on to bitterness.
- The Bible is alive to you, you know God is speaking to you through it, and you want to read it.
- You can't be comfortable living in sin. Sin in your life makes you miserable.
- You want to humble yourself before God and become less and less so that God can become more and more in your life.
- Your motives are just that you love God and want to please Him. Your motives are not fear or guilt – but LOVE.

4. When you totally belong to HIM, you want to deal with the flesh. How?
Examine: Galatians 5:24-25

5. There must be the right alignment without condescension or provocation.
Examine: Galatians 5:25-26
